## STYLE IN MOTION



Known for his stylistic approach to musical freestyle, Ray has choreographed some of the top freestyle routines seen in both Paws 2 Dance and WCFO competitions as well as the first-of-its-kind theatrical production *Escape the Darkness*.

Join Ray April 29 (the day following Paws 2 Dance's *Prancing Paws* competition) when he will walk handlers through basic movements with the addition of stylistic features.



### ***When is a “weave” more than a “weave”?***

Start with a basic move – say a weave or a circle. Ray will show handlers stylistic variations that will make the basic move come to life in a variety of styles including western, jazz, contemporary, hip-hop, dramatic, and Latin.

Body position, head position, arm movement, hand movement, finger shape, foot placement . . . each contributes to the overall effect and Ray will demonstrate how to get the most impact out of each move. Handlers will have the opportunity to try each move in a variety of styles – with and without their dogs.

For the final part of the workshop, handlers are invited to present a segment of their routines. Ray will give tips on how to enhance the style of the movements within the selected segment.
